

2015 RED CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE RATING: 94 DUNNUCK SEPTEMBER 2017

One of my favorite straight Chateauneufs was this effort from Saint Siffrein. It boasts remarkable ripeness and power without any heat, incredibly pure raspberries and stone fruit, rich, velvety tannins that never seem obtrusive and a long, intense finish. It should drink well on release and possess at least 15 years of longevity.

2014 RED CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE RATING: (89-91) DUNNUCK SEPTEMBER 2015 Maturity: 2024

The ruby, opaque colored 2014 Châteauneuf offers lots of incense, toasted spice and Provencal herbs in a pretty, elegant, pure style. It has outstanding potential and does well in the vintage. I'm sure it will be approachable in its youth as well.

2013 RED CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE "Terre d'Abel" RATING: 90+ SEPT. 2015 Maturity : 2017-2027

Much more elegant and seamless, if not a touch sexy, the 2013 Châteauneuf du Pape Terre d'Abel is made from 50% Mourvèdre, 30% Syrah and 20% Grenache, all of which spent 12 months in 400-liter barrels. Loaded with notions of black raspberries, blueberries, crème brûlée and violets, it's medium to full-bodied, lightly textured, has fine tannin and a great finish. It will be better in another year or two and evolve nicely for a decade after that.

Dark garnet. Lightly chemical on the nose. Then broad and beefy. Already quite evolved - without massive tannins in evidence. Good for beefy short-term pleasure? Hint of yeast extract.

Drink 2016-2017

Tasted blind. Meat extract on the nose. Very opulent and rich with quite a charge of fine tannins. Solid stuff but it all adds up. Some attractive richness and not too alcoholic.

CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE RED 2014 OCT. 2015

Dark red. This has a brooding, quite deeply fruited aroma - loganberries spring to mind - with reduction, so it needs air. The palate spreads broadly and runs well, the tannins smooth, like the texture. Is it well juiced. This has promise, and enough weight to be a true Chateauneuf. Fine, powdered tannins close it.

2015 RED CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE

DECEMBER 2016

NOTE: (91-93)/100

Bright ruby-red. Aromas and flavors of ripe red and blue fruits take on floral and peppery spice notes as the wine opens up. Silky and expansive on the palate, showing very good depth as well as energy and back-end lift. Leaves notes of candied flowers and allspice behind on the gently gripping, subtly tannic, very persistent finish.

2013 RED CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE « Terre d'Abel » FEBRUARY 2016 NOTE: 90/100

Vivid ruby-red. An exotically perfumed bouquet displays ripe red and blue fruit scents, along with exotic incense and apricot flourishes. Sweet and expansive on the palate, offering plush black raspberry and boysenberry flavors sharpened by a hint of white pepper. Suggestions of licorice and botanical herbs come up on the clinging finish, which is framed by dusty, building tannins.
