





# Domaine SAINT SIFFREIN Châteauneuf du Pape Red 2020

AOC Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Vallée du Rhône, France

### TRADITION

Harmonious and elegant wine with soft tannins, true to its terroir. Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, Cinsault.

Matured for 1 year in large oak vats.

#### THE VINTAGE

2020: a round and balanced vintage

#### LOCATION

The Domaine is situated in the area of the CHATEAUNEUF DU PAPE Appellation.

#### TERROIR

The terroir is clavey-chalky with large rounded sun-warmed stones, which diffuse a gentle, providential heat that helps the grapes to mature.

#### IN THE VINEYARD

For 40 years, we cultivate the vineyard with agriculture in an environmental friendly way. The yield is low : 35 hl/ha.

The grapes are harvested by hand with a selection of the best grapes.

#### WINEMAKING

The grapes are partial destemmed, slighty crushed and placed in a fermentation concrete tank. Long vatting time at controlled temperature from 25 days, with pumping-over to obtain a reasoned extraction of tannins.

#### AGEING

Maturing is done during 12 months on oak casks (45 hl) for 75 % and in tanks for 25%. It's bottled at the Domaine.

Complex of black fruits with hints of garrigue.
